In trays we will be hiding letters amongst lots of shredding paper, children will be encouraged to find the letters in their name and say the phonic sound. Children will be encouraged to write the letters they have found.

In the garden area children will take part in a number hunt, once they have found all the numbers, they will be encouraged to put them in order. They will then find objects to match the numeral.

In the sensory tray children will take part in a lucky dip, they will be encouraged to guess what they have found and describe how it feels.

In the outdoor area small groups of children will play hide and seek with their friends.

We will be looking at the story We are going on a bear hunt. Children will be encouraged draw maps of how to find the bear.
